Our History

The Green & Gold Hosta Society was established in 1997 to bring together Northeastern Wisconsin gardeners interested in the genus Hosta.

The society's purpose is to educate members about hostas in the landscape, plus hybridizing, propagating, growing, and maintaining hosta plants, and to share plants and ideas with the Northeastern Wisconsin community and beyond.

Since 1999, the Green & Gold has maintained a hosta garden at the Green Bay Botanical Garden. In 2011, the garden was designated as an official American Hosta Society National Display Garden.

convention and the 2019 American Hosta
Society national convention.

Activities

Our annual meeting is held each April and includes a short business meeting, speaker, door prizes, and more.

As part of our goal to share ideas, we hold monthly Chit Chat garden tours hosted by society members during the summer months. The first Chit Chat held in June also features a plant sale.

The Green & Gold also hosts an annual "Road Trip," a one-day bus trip to visit gardens outside the Green Bay area.

In September, we hold another plant sale. In October, we enjoy a Fall Harvest Festival dinner which includes a speaker.
